

REGULAR MEETING OF THE WELLSBORO MUNICIPAL AUTHORITY
April 18, 2023

The meeting of the Wellsboro Municipal Authority was called to order by Bob DeCamp on Tuesday, April 18, 2023 at 4:04 p.m. Meeting in the Council Room of the Borough Office at 14 Crafton Street were Bob DeCamp, Terry Bryant, Ed Owlett and Daren Getty, constituting a quorum. Secretary/Treasurer Amy Kane Perry and Borough Manager Louis Rachiele were also in attendance. The Pledge of Allegiance was said by all.

Public Comments on Agenda Items-none

Daren Getty made a motion to accept the minutes of the March 21, 2023 Wellsboro Municipal Meeting. The motion was seconded by Terry Bryant and carried.

Items:

Diversified Oil & Gas Royalty – We received \$99,223.22 this month.

STL Resources – Borough Manager Louis Rachiele will draft a letter for bulk station withdrawal using template used by former manager Scot F. Boyce, Jr.

Water Sales – Water sales totaled 149,150 gallons for the month of March. Revenue was \$1,044.05.

Banik Well Conveyance Line – Borough Manager Louis Rachiele gave an update from Larson Design Group. The Costars approved contractors quote came in much higher than anticipated. The Authority would like to ask around and determine if they would like to send it out for bid. They also would like to determine if the project can be completed with a 4” pipe instead of the 6” recommended.

Pay Bills

Ed Owlett made a motion to ratify the payment of bills and pay bills in the amount of \$43,059.54 Daren Getty seconded the motion and it carried.

Other Business-

A letter was received by Craig Davenport of 4 Ives Street regarding the water pressure at his residence. It is understood that the water pressure drops once it reaches the outer limits on the line. It is common practice for individuals to install boosters to help combat these issues. This will be relayed to Mr. Davenport by Borough Manager Louis Rachiele.
